- Students participating in the program will be dismissed from their homeroom teacher to the cafeteria at the end of the regular school day (younger students will be escorted).
- If classes are cancelled due to inclement weather, one (and only one) make-up day is scheduled for Wed, Mar 6. No refunds will be given for cancellations due to inclement weather.

Overlook's 2019 ASEP Class Descriptions

- **Briar Bush** - Grades K,1,2
Special guest educators bring the Briar Bush Nature Center to Overlook. Each week is a themed activity hand-picked by Briar Bush educators based on age and interest. A great choice for nature lovers and hands-on learners.
- **Cupcake Decorating** – Grades 1,2,3,4
Who doesn't love a deliciously sweet and beautifully decorated cupcake? Learn techniques to decorate like the pros. A fun and delicious class taught by parent and talented baker Lidia Banh.
- **Drama Club** - Grades 2,3,4,5,6
Taught by Theatre Horizon. An exciting opportunity for students to learn how to use their voice, body and imagination to create characters and to tell a story that they perform in an original play.
- **Nature Adventures** - Grades 2,3,4
Join 2nd grade teacher Mrs. Brown and reconnect with nature. Learn about birds, make fun crafts and explore the great outdoors. Weather permitting, the group will take nature walks, do a bird watch and plant a garden.
- **Art Club** - Grades K,1,2
Join Penn State students for an art class geared just for the younger kids. Each week will feature a different art project from drawing and painting to clay molding.
- **Lego Club** - Grades K,1,2
Join a club where you can build, create and design with Legos! This class allows children to explore engineering and creativity while having brick loads of fun! Weekly challenges will give direction and purpose to each week. With Overlook parents Laura Ramsay and Gretchen Tait.
- **Karate** - Grades 2,3,4
Learning the martial arts is about more than just getting in shape! In this fun and fast-paced class, students will build confidence, self-discipline, and self-defense skills in a safe, controlled environment. Students will be introduced to the foundations of the martial arts. Students will also learn skills to help them identify and diffuse bullying situations. - **Board Game Club** – Grades 3,4,5,6
Are you a board game master, or working to improve your skills? Join 4th grade teachers Mr. Staszkiw, Ms. Eberman, Ms. Swedberg and Ms. Kelly for some board game fun! Show off your talents and learn some new tricks of the trade!
- **Scrappy Circuits** - Grades 3,4,5,6
Join 3rd Grade teacher Mr. Carroll in this innovative and scrappy way to learn about electrical circuits. Students will build circuits using recycled materials and even incorporate them into an arcade game made out of cardboard.
- **Sports Club (multiple groupings)** - Grades 3,4,5,6
Abington High School Varsity Athletes and Ms Early will lead kids through a range of sports. A great way for kids to stay moving in the winter months. The class will be a combination of skill instruction and team play.
- **Cooking Club** – Grades 4,5,6
This club will focus on learning and preparing a variety of foods. Students will learn about nutrition, preparation methods, and some of the inner workings of a kitchen. Children will also have opportunities to bring home samples to share with the family! Led by 5th grade teacher Mr. Coates.
- **Spanish Club** – Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6
This Spanish class is a great opportunity for students to practice the language and learn about Hispanic culture. Students will participate in various activities to strengthen their understanding of language and cultural differences which can lead to a whole new world of exciting possibilities and experiences. - **Mural Art** - Grades 4,5,6

- **Cheerleading** – Grades 3,4,5,6
Show some overlook pride with the captains of the Senior High Varsity Cheer Team! You will learn cheers, a dance, jumps, and a stunt so dress comfortably and come with spirit!
- **Advanced Origami Club** – Grades 5,6
The Origami club gives students the opportunity to develop their origami and crafting skills. Students will review the basics of paper folding and then venture to complete works of origami art!
- **Hand Sewing Projects** – Grades 3,4,5,6
